



New Zealand Actors Agents Guild Inc.

Code Of Ethics

Membership of the Guild shall be conditional on the member accepting this Code of Ethics.....

No Joining or registration fees to be charged to actors

Agents terms of business including current commission rate to be clearly stated and agreed at the commencement of representation. Any change to the commission rate must be sent to the actor in writing

- a) Commission fees not to exceed 15%
- b) Booking fees not to exceed 20%

Payments to actors to be made as soon as cheques have been cleared unless other arrangements have previously been agreed with the actor.

No member may claim to have authority to offer the services of or in any other way represent an actor except with the specific consent of that actor.

No Member shall undertake representation of an actor who has previously been represented without satisfying themselves that the actor has terminated in writing their earlier representation.

All written contracts and all verbal or written submissions shall entitle the organising agent to all commissions for the life of the contract.

No member in advising or negotiating on behalf of a client shall be governed by any other consideration than a conscientious regard for the professional welfare of the actor.

No member having any interest in any enterprise shall negotiate for the services of or the property of an actor in such an enterprise without first disclosing the member's interest to that actor.

No member of the guild shall approach or solicit, directly or indirectly, any actor represented by another Guild member with the intent of persuading the actor to join their agency.

No member shall make disparaging remarks or adversely comment on the behaviour or practices of another Guild member without Guild approval.

No member shall operate in any other enterprise deemed by the Guild to be a conflict of interest, such as

- a) to undertake work as a Casting Director
- b) In house teaching of own clients for monetary gain.
